Mr Nicholls made it clear that he could not provide quotations or firm prices at this stage . However, when pressed for an answer, as a rough rule-of-thumb he suggested £10,000 per car space was a reasonable figure which might give us some frame of reference.

So, looking at the small area outside the Chinese Takeaway. There is sufficient scope for an extra vehicle space approx £10,000 (including approx £1000 for road closure)

Looking at Chapel Road. It would be possible for a 3 car layby roughly opposite Chatten Close at a cost of approx £30,000.

Mr Nicholls said that if the Parish Council resolved to pursue these matters further, then he would obtain firm quotes.

I asked about many other associated things including Traffic Control Orders (for road closures and things like speed restrictions and yellow lines) , permissions for Parish bus shelters, Parish benches and Parish street lighting, and whether County provide

other car park spaces etc.

I asked about getting a price list for Highways jobs - Mr Nicholls might be able to provide if we keep chasing although we need to be specific about the jobs.

There was much conversation about many other things which I believe Parish Clerk, Chairman & Councillors are already aware of eg having to use Suffolk approved Contractors, County Councillors having Highways budgets etc etc
